#### COVID UPDATE - FREEDOM DAY OR NOT?

The media have latched on to this coming Monday at being Freedom Day, when all COVID restrictions are ended. But of course it was never going to be that simple. What the Prime Minister actually said last week was all legal restrictions would end but that we should continue to follow the restrictions out of personal responsibility. We all know this means some people will and some will not, and those who are relying on everyone following the now unwritten rules because they still need to shield will experience the opposite of freedom day.

In an establishment like the church, the COVID laws may not apply but other laws (such as the Health and Safety at Work Act) still do. Moreover as your Rector I have a moral and ethical obligation to make your place of worship a safe place to be, including for those who might be classed as clinically vulnerable. The Church of England has released new detailed guidance covering churches and church worship. Irene and I will be looking at this over the next weeks and consulting with PCCs over the next steps. These will be implemented in a cautious manner so please do not expect everything to go back to how it was before COVID by next Sunday. Revd Eddie.
